## COACHES VOLUNTEER AGREEMENT BETWEEN DEVELOPMENT/REPRESENTATIVE SQUAD COACHES & THE NORTHERN TASMANIAN JUNIOR SOCCER ASSOCIATION (INC) ABN: 168 583 884 76

I \_\_\_\_\_ Coach of the Under \_\_\_\_\_ sex \_\_\_\_\_ with the Northern Tasmanian Junior Soccer Association Inc. for \_\_\_\_\_ (season) agree to take on the position on a solely voluntary basis and will not hold the NTJSA responsible for any costs incurred for accommodation, airfares, traveling, tracksuits or by way of wages or loss of earnings etc. This agreement is only for the \_\_\_\_\_ soccer season while officially appointed as official to be involved with the above mentioned squad.

The NTJSA agrees to reimburse the set costs not exceeding a total of \$ \_\_\_\_\_ involved in out of pocket expenses, payable on the invoice.

The NTJSA will register free of charge the Team Manager/Team Coach/Team Trainer as financial members, all others must pay the prescribed membership fees to become members so that they are covered for public liability and for injuries sustained as a result of their involvement with the team. I will accept what the insurance company compensates me with seeking no further compensation from the NTJSA.

1. I, as (position) \_\_\_\_\_ of the Team will be responsible for returning all soccer balls, strips, first aid kit and any other equipment belonging to the NTJSA at the completion of the tournament or carnival.
2. I agree to obtain lists of qualified players from the Association Secretary & view players during normal roster matches.
3. I agree not to approach Development/Representative players that I am involved with in an effort to persuade them to play with another junior club, school or senior club.
4. I agree to use the official NTJSA tracksuit, Rep team strips in all Representative/Development competition or friendly games either locally or inter/intrastate and/or your own acceptable sports uniform and footwear during training.
5. I agree that no sponsors' strips or other equipment will be used unless approved by the Executive Board. Should a company or individual wish to sponsor any team to travel away, approval must first be obtained from the NTJSA.
6. I am aware that when seeking sponsorship no team official is to approach any company or individual already associated with the NTJSA.
7. I agree that all team members must have their registration details up to date before taking to the field of play before their first tournament match. This includes a current registration form being completed and their fees paid in full.
8. I agree to be fair and unbiased with player selections and to give all players reasonable time on the field during training and tournament games.
9. I am aware that in my appointment as Coach I am required to attend any development information sessions conducted by Football Federation Tasmania or the NTJSA.
10. I agree that any interstate trips involving traveling teams are organized through an NTJSA approved Tour Company.
11. I agree that teams traveling interstate and overseas will forward an itinerary to the NTJSA prior to departure and that any friendly or promotional matches are approved by the Executive Board, including local games.
12. I agree to forward a report to The Secretary (PO Box 157, Mowbray Heights 7248) within 14 days of completion of the tournament outlining the team's performance and achievements.
13. I agree that all publicity is to go through the NTJSA Secretary and in return to advise the Executive Board.
14. I agree that all purchases of equipment, tracksuits, team strips etc are to be made through the NTJSA Property Official or Rep Team Liaison Official.
15. I agree to obey all the Rules and By-Laws of the NTJSA as well as cooperating with all NTJSA Officials and other team officials.
16. I agree to carry out my duties as team official as highlighted in the NTJSA Constitution and Rep Team Guidelines booklet.
17. I agree to ensure that all players are notified by mail through the NTJSA Secretary (using an NTJSA set letter) informing them as to whether they have made the final squad or not.
18. I agree not to organise venues for training or practice matches or training under floodlights that will incur a cost to the NTJSA for hire and agree to use authorized central training venues at all times unless permission has been gained from the NTJSA Executive Board first to use other training/practice match venue/s.
19. I agree not to do or say and be involved in any activities that is detrimental to the NTJSA and Club/Schools policies and programs.
20. I agree to abide by the NTJSA's strong Code Of Conduct when officiating in any Tournament Match or training session.
21. I agree to provide NTJSA a current police record check if this is required for me to do so.

Failure to comply with any of the above listed terms will result in instant dismissal as a Team Official, and could result in cancellation of your Association membership by the Executive Board.

### CODE OF CONDUCT FOR TEAM OFFICIALS OF NTJSA, CLUBS/SCHOOLS

**ABN: 168 583 884 76**

By applying for registration with the NTJSA and or with a Club/school that is a member or affiliate of the NTJSA and for applying for a position as Team Official, accepts responsibility for complying with the code of conduct detailed below. The Team Official also agrees to the consequences of any breach of the code of conduct. These may include, depending on the nature and severity of the breach:

- Ejection from the field of play.
- Fine or suspension by the Club.
- Fine or suspension by the NTJSA.
- Revoking of membership and of any position I may have or hold with the NTJSA Clubs/Schools
- And/or legal proceedings - civil or criminal for conduct unlawful under State or Federal law. In the connection please take particular note of Condition 10 below.

Please read the code of conduct carefully and sign the statement underneath it.

#### NTJSA Code of Conduct for Team Officials

Whilst performing their duties of a team, associated with a member Club/school or with the NTJSA, Team Officials will:

1. Attend training sessions and matches at times advised by the Club/School or NTJSA. If unable, for a valid reason to do so, Team Officials will inform the Club/School or the NTJSA Secretary and Representative Team Officials as soon as is practical.
2. Act respectfully towards the officials and players of their own and opposing Clubs/Schools or Representative Team.
3. Ensure that your membership with the NTJSA is current.
4. Act respectfully towards match officials at all times. Abusive, insulting or offensive language violent conduct, sexual, racial and other forms of harassment towards any person are totally unacceptable.
5. Avoid individual or collective behaviour, which may reasonably be held by spectators to be offensive.
6. Avoid all acts likely to incite spectators to violence or disorder.
7. Make no detrimental statements in public (to others, the radio or media print) in respect of any incidents or Performance against any player, match official, opposition official, club or NTJSA Official or any policy decision of the Club/School or the NTJSA.
8. Abide by the constitution and By-Laws of your Club and of the NTJSA and I will not do, say or be involved in any activities that is detrimental to the NTJSA, Club/Schools policies and programs.
9. Respect the facilities and equipment of their own and opposing Clubs/schools and the NTJSA.
10. Ensure that all players in your charge are made aware of their responsibilities under the Code of Conduct and take all reasonable steps to ensure that players adhere to it, taking particular note of Condition 10 of the Players code of Conduct regarding the unacceptability of violent conduct and any sexual, racial and other forms of harassment as defined in some sections of the Constitution and By-Laws.
11. To only play players registered and playing with the NTJSA competition in a team you are involved with and who are eligible to play as per By-Law 42 and as per Section 41.1 up to and including 42.24 of the Constitution. Give all players reasonable time on the field during the game.
12. To be aware of the Constitution Representative Teams Guidelines section 41.1 up to and including 42.24.
13. To be aware of the Constitution Racial Vilification Policy, Section 43 up to and including 43.3.
