Formats

The format of the competition for each age group is determined on the numbers in each group. The final format for your age group cannot be confirmed until all entries have been received and numbers confirmed. To give an **example** though of what may occur.

5 teams in group - Play each other once with 4 games each. The team with the most points at the end of the tournament will be declared the winner.

8-10 Teams in group - Split into two groups. One group/division of four teams could play three games each plus a 4th game via 1v2 and 3v4. Or the winners of each group could play for the 1st place of the age group.

These are purely examples.
